The Rugby World Cup 2019 was held in Japan. It was the first time in Asia. The Japanese national team was among the best eight teams, which was also a first-time \*achievement. There was another first thing that happened during the event.

“Scrum Unison” is a project started by Mr. Toshiro Hirose, former Rugby captain. A singer-song writer, Mr. Takumi Murata, and a singer, Ms. Misato Tanaka, helped him. What is the Scrum Union? It’s a project to sing the \*national anthems of 20 countries \*participating in the event. They posted videos on YouTube of 20 national anthems and they made \*lyrics cards in their native languages with *katakana* and meanings in Japanese.

When each national anthem was sung by thousands of Japanese fans at a stadium, \*representatives and people from all over the world were very surprised and felt so happy. Scrum Unison can be said to be an example of Japanese *omotenashi* to show our friendship.

A typhoon is a natural \*phenomenon. Many typhoons hit Japan in 2019 and caused a lot of serious damage to many areas. We, however, have never heard that a typhoon hits the US or India. Instead, we hear that a hurricane hit Mexico or Florida and that a cyclone hit Indonesia.

Do you know the difference between a typhoon, a hurricane, and a cyclone? 5  
When a \*tropical cyclone with strong winds is in \*the South China Sea or near Japan, it is called a typhoon. When it is near Central America and the \*Northeast Pacific, it is called a hurricane. When it is in the northern Indian Ocean, southern Indian Ocean, or southern Pacific Ocean, it is called a cyclone.

The \*standard maximum wind speed of typhoons, hurricanes, and 10  
cyclones are \*33m/s or higher. Only in Japan, a typhoon of 17m/s or higher is called “*taifu*.”

Recently, we often hear the words “automatic driving.” There are TV commercials showing a driver taking his hands off the wheel while driving. You may not be interested in cars now because you are too young to get your driver’s license. However, in the near future, we might see junior high school students drive their own cars to school or club activities if all cars are automatically driven. When do you think we can drive an automatic car which we don’t have to drive? 5

There are six levels in automatic driving. At level 0, there is no automatic operation and a driver controls everything. The level 1 and 2 are driving support technology, not automatic driving. Automatic driving is at levels 3, 4, and 5. In Japan, we can drive level 2 cars, but we can’t buy level 3 cars because there are still a lot of problems with them. 10

Automatic driving cars may be able to stop accidents caused by human errors. They may help old people or handicapped people to move more easily. But we have to solve the problem of who is responsible when an accident happens before those cars run on public roads. 15
