There are many special places and beautiful areas of nature in Okinawa and the world. For example, there are Shurijo Castle and Nakijin-jo sites in Okinawa. People in Okinawa were very sad when they saw Shurijo Castle on fire on TV in 2019, but they have started to build it again.

To protect these important places and nature as our world treasures forever, \*The World Heritage Convention was created in 1972 by \*the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). More than 190 countries have joined the convention.

The World Heritage sites are chosen by UNESCO. There are three types of World Heritage sites: 1) cultural, 2) natural, and 3) cultural and natural mixed. For example, \*the Taj Mahal in India, and the Pyramids of Egypt belong to the World Cultural Heritage sites. The Grand Canyon in the USA is one of the World Natural Heritage sites, and \*the Kakadu National Park in Australia belongs to the World Mixed Heritage sites.

How many World Heritage sites are there in Japan now? There are 20 World Cultural Heritage sites, 5 World Natural Heritage sites and 0 World Mixed sites in Japan. Here in Okinawa, Shurijo Castle and other historic places were added to the World Cultural Heritage sites in 2000. In June 2021, some areas of Okinawa and Kagoshima were made into the World Natural Heritage site.
