





"Breakfast is the most important meal of the day." Many people agree with this idea, but some find it hard to eat in the morning. According to a survey, about one-quarter of men and women in Okinawa skip breakfast daily, and it is said that this percentage of people who don't eat breakfast is the highest in Japan.

"How often do you have breakfast?" Junior high school students in Okinawa were asked about breakfast. About 82 % of them said they ate it every morning and about 3 % of the students said they always skipped breakfast. Surprisingly, about 18 % of the 3rd-grade students in junior high school said they always skipped breakfast. Some of my friends who don't eat breakfast often say, "I don't have time to eat" or "I'm not hungry in the morning." Students think in different ways about breakfast, but let's find out why it is so important.

Eating breakfast in the morning will give you energy and you can begin your day feeling good. If you do not eat breakfast and always feel hungry, you will not have full energy to do daily things. Skipping breakfast can lead to problems at school. For example, you may not want to have fun with your friends because of feeling tired. It may also be difficult for you to concentrate in your first-period English class because your *body temperature rises more slowly. Some *experts say that students who eat breakfast every morning do better in class than students who skip breakfast. *Moreover, eating breakfast *regularly may also help students keep a healthy weight.

You may be very busy every day. Some of you may think you don't need to take the time to eat in the morning, but skipping breakfast is not a good idea. To make your day happy and healthy, it's important for you to eat breakfast. Fifteen minutes for breakfast is much better for you than fifteen minutes of extra sleep.
