



## 第6問

My name is Yuto, and I am a third-year student in Konan High School. Today, I'm going to talk about the study tour that we went on last winter. One of the best experiences was the exchange meeting with international students. This event taught me the importance of understanding different cultures.

During the exchange meeting, we had the chance to introduce Okinawan traditional cultures to the international students in English. We prepared a presentation with slides about various Okinawan cultures, such as food, history, nature, castles, words, and music. It was exciting to share our tradition and see the international students' interests in Okinawan cultures.

One of the highlights of the meeting was our performance of *Eisa* and *Sanshin*, two traditional Okinawan performing arts. *Eisa* is a form of local dance that is usually performed during the *Obon* festival. The sound and energy of the drumming and dancing attracted the audience. We played a few traditional songs, and the sound of the *Sanshin* added a unique and beautiful feeling to the event. The international students seemed to enjoy it very much and asked many questions about our culture. It was a great chance for us to speak English and explain our traditions to them. Their true interests made us feel proud of Okinawa.

At the end of the exchange meeting, we all sang "\*Tinsagu nu Hana" together. This song is a traditional Okinawan folk song that speaks about the beauty of Okinawan nature and the wisdom of our \*ancestors. Even if most of them didn't understand the \*lyrics, they tried their best to sing along, and it created a sense of \*unity and respect each other.

This exchange meeting taught me the value of cultural exchange. It was not only about sharing our own cultures but also about learning from others. I realized that we have our differences, but we can connect and build friendships through respecting and understanding each other. I am glad to have this chance and look forward to more experiences like this in the future.
